Cassubia – a new generic name for Pomerania Lendzion, 1975

In 1975 a new generic name *Pomerania* was proposed for specimen of *Trilobitoidea* found in the Lower Cambrian (K. Lendzion, 1975). However, it appeared that the name *Pomerania* has been earlier used for one of the genera of *Ammonoidea*, typical of the Upper Jurassic, by J. W. Arkell (1937). In accordance with the Rules of the International Zoological Code the generic name proposed for the Lower Cambrian specimen should be replaced with a new one as it was introduced later than the Arkell's name. Therefore, the name *Cassubia* is proposed for the Lower Cambrian specimen of *Trilobitoidea* and the name *Pomerania infracambriensis* Lendzion (1975) is changed into *Cassubia infracambriensis* Lendzion. *Cassubia* is latinized name of Kaszuby region from the central Pomerania, where the specimen *Cassubia infracambriensis* Lendzion was found in core material of the borehole Kościerzyna.
